It has been more than twenty-five years since the Passmore log cabin has been reconstructed. This year the Society will be doing some needed repairs. The wood shakes on the roof are in bad shape and need to be replaced. We received estimates and have chosen a roofer. We have applied for a grant and are looking at other ways to help finance it. Also, a small metal shed from Home Depot will be purchased to put near the cabin. Depot reduced their price significantly to help us with the purchase. Cleanup of the second floor, painting the window frames and other small jobs will be done to keep up this significant historical building in our township.
